

2.10.19 L.O. Adding and subtracting calculations in word problems.

✓ Eg. In a field there are 2,356 rabbit holes. The farmer jilld in 789 of them in 1 day. How many will need jilling tomorrow?

$$\begin{array}{r} 2356 \\ - 789 \\ \hline 1567 \end{array}$$

He has 1567 more holes to jill.

✓ 1. Peter found 2362 marbles in his attic. He gave 1687 marbles to Tom. How many marbles did he keep.

$$\begin{array}{r} 2362 \\ - 1687 \\ \hline 675 \end{array}$$

He kept 675 marbles.

✓ 2. A football costs £13.57 and football boots cost £82.32. How much more did the boots cost than the ball?

$$\begin{array}{r} 82.32 \\ - 13.57 \\ \hline 68.75 \end{array}$$

✓ 3. A pet shop sold a puppy for £435.27 and a kitten for £236.99. How much money did the shopkeeper make?

$$\begin{array}{r} 435.27 \\ + 236.99 \\ \hline 672.26 \end{array}$$

✓ 4. Tesco have 2,356 workers and Asda have 6,397. How many workers are there altogether?

$$\begin{array}{r} 6397 \\ + 2356 \\ \hline 8753 \end{array}$$

✓ 5. A farmer sold 296 of his 523 sheep. How many has he got left?

$$\begin{array}{r} 523 \\ - 296 \\ \hline 227 \end{array}$$

✓ 6. In January 3.76 cm of rain fell in Dublin. 15.9 cm fell in February. How much rain fell altogether in the two months?

$$\begin{array}{r} 15.9 \\ + 3.76 \\ \hline 19.66 \end{array}$$

✓ 7. In Stanhope school there are 154 children. There are 139 in the town. How many children are there altogether?

$$\begin{array}{r} 154 \\ + 139 \\ \hline 293 \end{array}$$

✓ 8. Spangles cost £18.78, and Opel fruits cost £3.25. How much is a box of each altogether?

$$\begin{array}{r} 18.78 \\ + 3.25 \\ \hline 22.03 \end{array}$$

✓ 9. Jimmy is 1.75m tall. Tommy is 2.25m tall. How tall are both boys together?

$$\begin{array}{r} 2.25 \\ + 1.75 \\ \hline 4.00 \end{array}$$
