## Here are some of the things you could be doing:

Keeping safe – social distancing, personal hygiene
Caring for living things - taking care of our pets and plants
Playing together safely, taking turns, following social rules and playing fairly
Talking about people who help us in the community
Exploring the school environment - mini -beasts and flora
Name and sort mini- beasts and know some of their characteristics
Learn about life cycles - the butterfly and the frog
Use ICT to communicate - write captions and sentences using a word processing
programme
Exploring the immediate environment - go on a senses walk
Planting seeds – what do plants need to grow?
What does it mean to belong in Christianity? - Sunday as a special day
Singing number rhymes and songs.
Counting up and down from 10 and 20. Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
Separating and combining numbers
Role play - 'Garden Centre and café
Use vocabulary related to money
Shared reading - find out about the local environment
Shared writing - write labels/price tags for the role play areas
Sequence stories and identify rhyming words
Drawing and painting mini- beasts and flowers
Wax resist and pencil rubbings of leaves, stones and shells
