



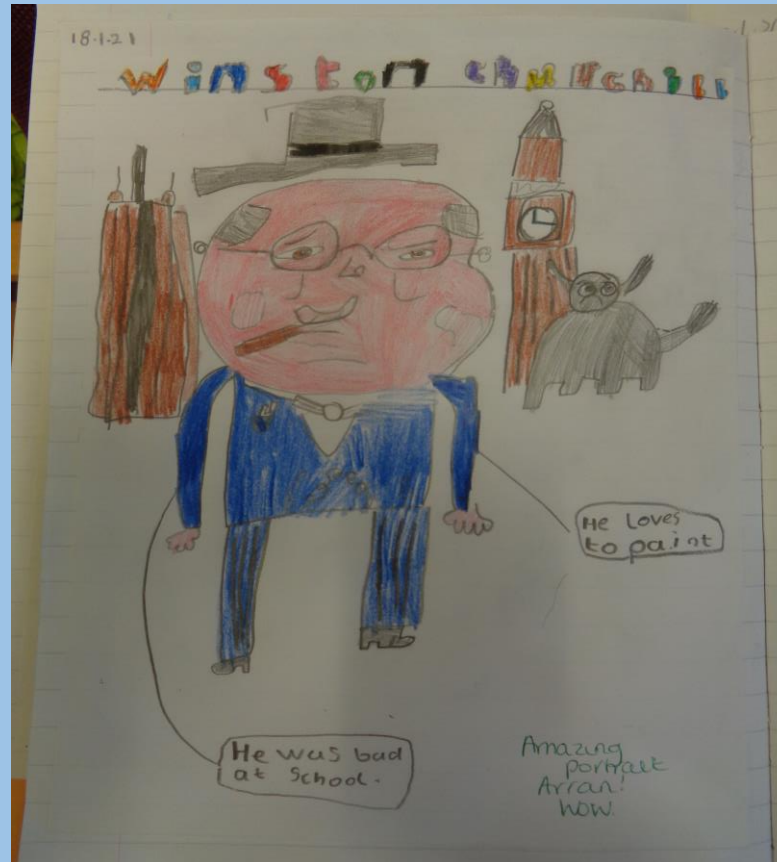

I like to swim in the cool water.

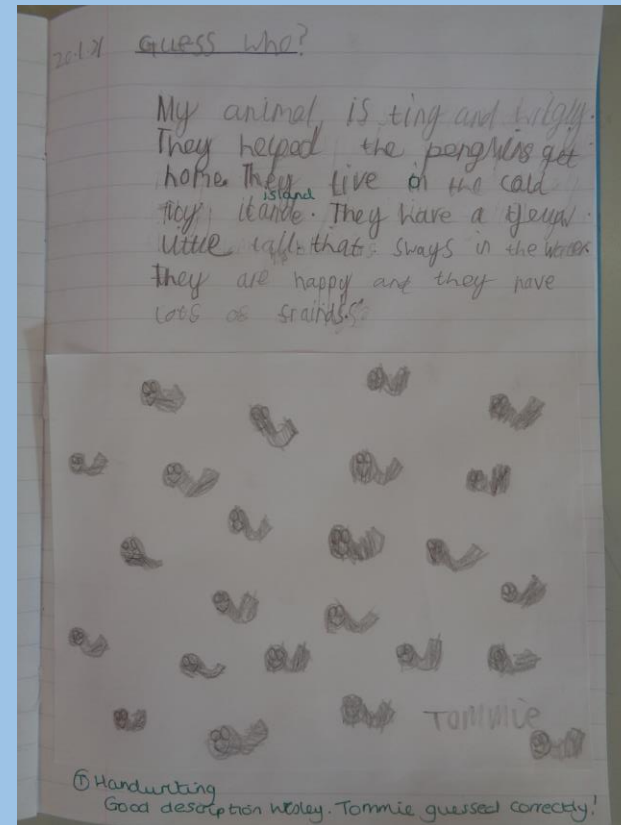
I may be small but I have strong muscles to push large icebergs.

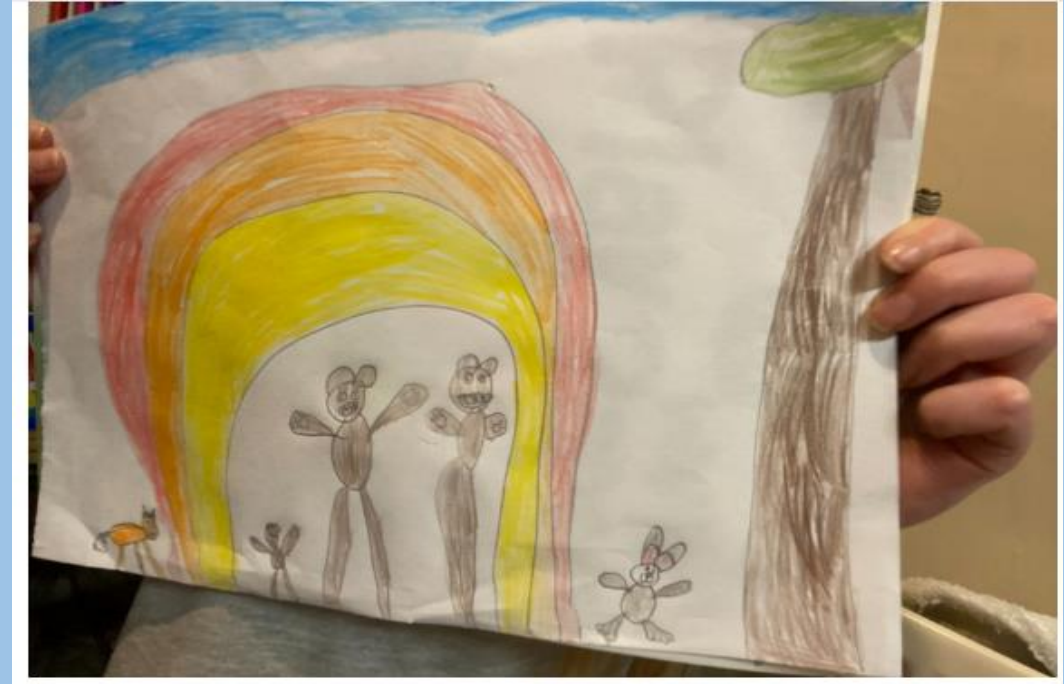
