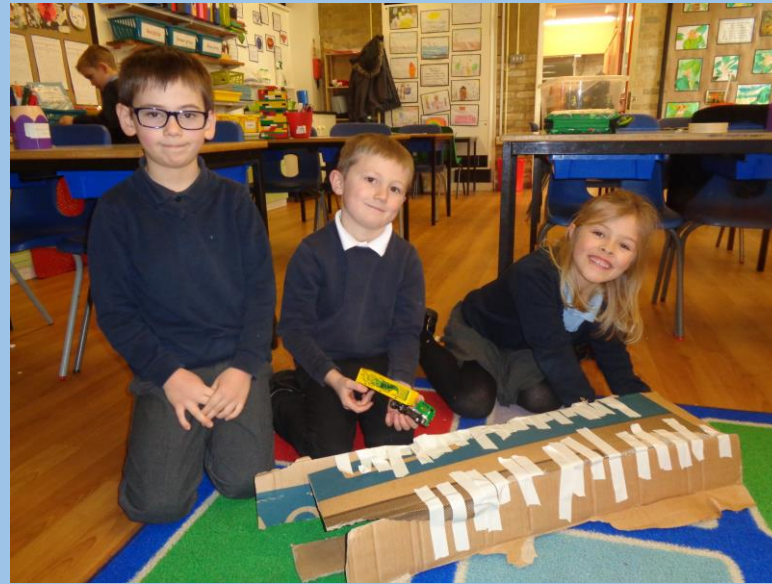
Class 2

The children in school used cardboard and lots of masking tape!



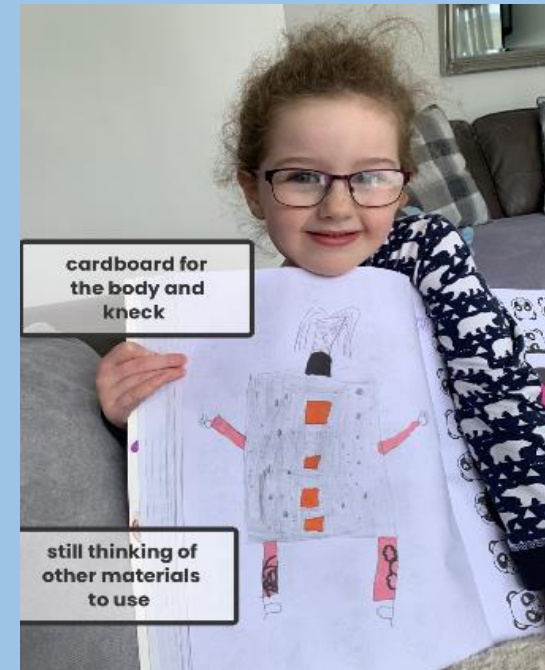
Logan built his using Lego.

Millie was very proud of her robot design! It was great!

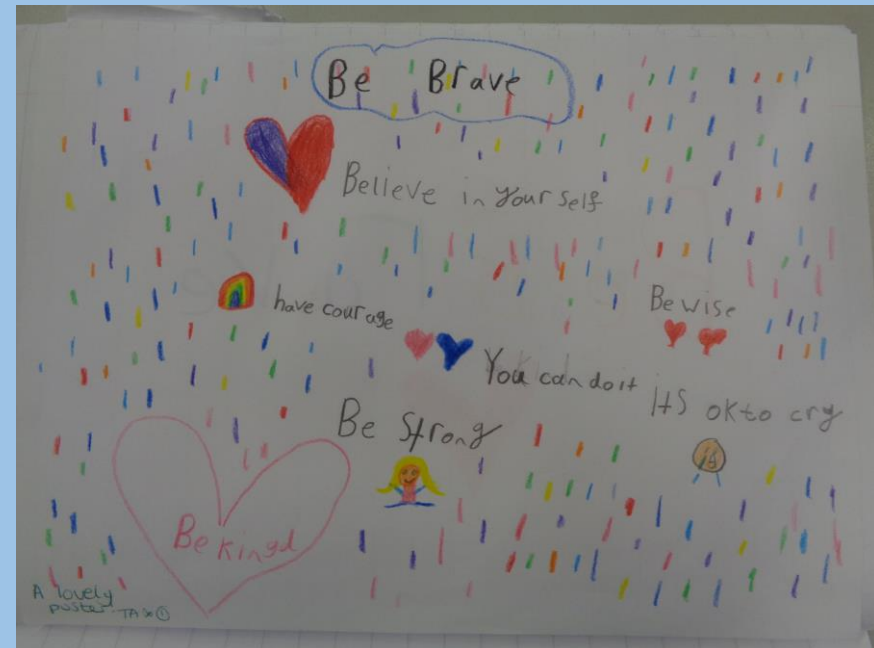
RE

Harriet thought carefully about what might encourage people to be brave.



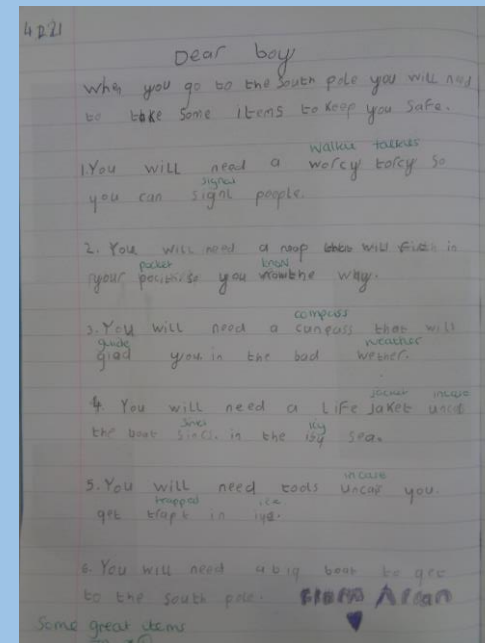
Literacy
