How to wash a Woolly Mammoth

Equipment needed

- Shampoo
- Sponge
- Brush
- Shower
- Hair Dryer
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste.
- Towel

Instructions

1. Wet the Mammoth in the shower.
2. Squirt the Shampoo onto the sponge and scrub the Mammoth until their is a good lather.
3. Thouroughly rinse off all of the suds.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make sure all of the dirt is removed.
4. Rub all over with a towel to remove any drips.
5. Brush all over making sure all knots and tangles are free.
6. Use the hair dryer until completely dry then repeat step 5.
7. Brush the tusks with the toothbrush and toothpaste until they are super shiny

Top Tip

Get the towel on the Mammoth as quickly as possible before it shakes water all over you.

What you will need:

- Soap / Shampoo
- Warm Water
- Sponge
- bucket
- tooth brush
- cloth / towel

Instructions

- 1 First, the wooly mammoth must be on a flat ground.
- 2 Second, mix the shampoo with the water in the bucket creating foam.
- 3 After that, wash the wooly mammoth with the foam on his belly.
- 4 Next, get the tooth brush and brush his tusks. Then, get the cloth rub the cloth on his tusks until they are pale white.
- 5 Then get the warm ^{soapy} water then dip the sponge in the water scrub him behind the ears, back, tail, head.
- 6 Finally dry him off with the towel.
