Consett Support Group is an existing well-established group which meets regularly with the opportunity for kinship carers to join.

Support groups provide the opportunity for kinship carers to come together, share stories, support each other, exchange advice and coping mechanisms. They are a great way to meet other kinship carers and help to reduce loneliness and isolation.

Recent, local feedback revealed that over 90% of kinship carers agreed that support groups made them feel part of the kinship carer community. Support groups have helped kinship carers keep in touch with other kinship carers, helping them feeling less isolated and has also provided the opportunity to listen to and share concerns about their current situation, as well as gaining practical knowledge about kinship care. Kinship carers have also expressed a real enjoyment from attending support groups and this is demonstrated from recent kinship carer feedback, which includes the statement below.

"Our kinship group is more like a family than a group, I always feel welcome and can message anyone for advice any time"

For kinship carers who require additional support, this may be provided by a one to one Kinship Project Worker for up to 6mths.
