Message from Mrs Cross

It has been fantastic to welcome our children and families back to school.

Relaxing some of our Covid restrictions has allowed the children to play together outside, to share lunchtime and to come together for Collective Worship. It has been a real joy to see older and younger children playing, exploring and learning together. We are very much mindful of the impact Covid has had (and is still having) on our children, families and staff team. Please be assured that a significant amount of work is being done in school to support everyone through this incredibly challenging time. This work includes: mental health training for our team, the training of a second Thrive Practitioner, whole school training in Thrive, use of Mindfulness within each Learning Zone, investment in books and resources to support children's mental health, events to support Mental Health Day, the establishment of a pupil voice Group called Happiness Heroes, establishment of two Mental Health Ambassadors among many more actions. As always, I am trying to take a reasonable line in deciding how we move forward taking account of such wide ranging views about Covid. Please be assured that every event and every decision is thoroughly thought through and has a detailed risk assessment written for it. I am trying very hard to make life as 'normal' as possible for everyone whilst keeping everyone safe. This is not an easy thing to achieve given some people are extremely anxious and others think that our remaining Covid restrictions are 'over the top'. I am confident that the approach we are taking is the right one and this seems to be borne out by the fact that during the whole pandemic we have only had to close 2 bubbles and at the current time of writing we have no positive cases in school.

COLOUR BLINDNESS TRAINING FOR STAFF

You may already know that Malachi (Diamond) has written a book called Colour Blindness & Me to share his experience of the challenges he lives with. A copy of Malachi's book is being sent to every school in County Durham and every primary school in the Durham & Newcastle Diocese. The book is also available from retailers in Stanhope and from Waterstones. Malachi and his Mum have kindly donated income from the sale of his book to fund training for our staff team to raise awareness and support staff to spot the indicators of colour blindness in children. Our training takes place on 19th October 2021.

THE NEW RSHE CURRICULUM

During lockdown the new RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health education) curriculum was introduced and became effective from September 2020.

At that time there were numerous consultation documents on our website, along with the draft policy for parents to comment on. However I am very much aware that everyone had other things on their mind during March—July 2020.
