## Walking Home Alone Guidance & Consent Form 2023-2024

## Walking Home Alone Guidance 2023-2024

Parents/Carers who want their child to walk home alone at the end of the school day must following the guidance below:

- Parents/carers must have registered with the school that they are prepared for their children to walk directly home from school at the end of the day
- Children must be in Year 5 or Year 6
- It is the parent/carer's responsibility to check the route that their children may
  use to walk home, in order that they may make an assessment of the
  appropriateness of the journey crossing of fast roads, walking through
  secluded areas etc.
- A single route must be agreed between child and parents/carers
- Parents/carers must be certain that children have an awareness and understanding of the level of alertness required to walk home safely
- Parents/carers must be certain that children have an awareness and understanding of how to cross roads and stranger danger
- It is parent's responsibility to ensure they are sufficiently happy that their child is capable of undertaking the proposed journey safely having considered all of the risks
- During inclement weather, children must be dressed appropriately
- Children should know their home phone number (plus one other emergency contact) and know how to seek help or use their own mobile phone
- Parents/carers understand that it is their responsibility and not the schools once your child has left the school premises to ensure they are home safely
- If your child is walking home alone and you have signed the consent form, your child's safety is your legal responsibility after 3.25pm when they are dismissed by their Class Teacher
