Our grant from the Weardale Area Action Partnership expires at the end of February. I am relieved to announce that we will continue to provide both Breakfast Club and After School Childcare, however, this may have to be in a different format and changes will be necessary if we are to continue with the provision. At the current time, without the grant funding we would be making a £1,500 loss so far this academic year and this is obviously not sustainable for the school.

I do however, understand how important this provision is for our working families; emergency situations; respite care and support and have therefore taken the decision to continue with the provision with some changes.
