Wrap Around Care:

Breakfast Club will open at 7.30am. You do not need to book a place as we have two Breakfast Club Supervisors so have sufficient adult to child ratio. Activities offered are timetabled and this is available to view on our website.

After School Childcare will to run from 3.15pm – 5pm. You do need to book a place for after school childcare as we only have one After School Supervisor and therefore may need to arrange further adult support if numbers increase on any particular day. Year 7 Drop in Session:

Every Monday, Mrs Parvin will be available for the children who have just left us to start secondary school if they would like to pay us a visit. The idea is that the children can still maintain a relationship with our school and a familiar trusted adult until such times that they can build similar relationships at their new school. It would also be lovely if they just want to pop in and say hello!

Football Club:

We have registered our Year 5&6 Football team into a league and these sessions will be training sessions to prepare for league matches. Matches tend to be held on a Wednesday after school at Parkside but more information will be shared with the team nearer the time. We will also need parent/carer volunteers to help with transport to and from the matches.

Reading Club:

Our Academy Counsellor with responsibility for literacy is an avid support of reading and is kindly offering this reading club for our KS2 children this half term. It is hoped that we can extend this for our younger children later in the year.

Lego Club:

This is a practical and engaging club which will help to develop fine motor skills and co-ordination skills in our younger children whilst they have lots of fun at the same time!

Choir:

We are hoping to establish a school choir and have been invited to take part in lots of fantastic events and performances across the year within the community including performing at the Weardale Railway Christmas Market.

Our clubs change every half term so if there is nothing here to inspire your child there may well be something coming up in the future which they are interested in doing.
