Dear Families,

I am sure you have noticed that Mrs Cross has not been in school as much as normal over the last two weeks. This is unfortunately due to some personal family circumstances which means she is unable to be in school at the moment and we have agreed she can have some time away from school in order to support her with this. As a Trust we talk about our children always being the most important people to us, but I am always quick to point out that without our amazing teams of staff we would not be who or where we are today.

During Mrs Cross' absence we have asked Mrs Green to act as Headteacher until after the Easter holidays with the support of the team at the Central Trust. The Senior Leadership Team in school have plans in place to ensure that any disruption to teaching and learning is minimised and therefore children in the Emerald Learning Zone will be taught by either Mrs Green or Mrs Lough (Higher Level Teaching Assistant) who already works with the class and who the children are very familiar with to ensure consistency for them.

I will be in school over the next two weeks to make sure Mrs Green has the support she needs and our estates Team are working as fast as they can to install the new boilers.
