The sessions will include:

#### 1. RSHE Curriculum (Mrs Cross)

Our RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) policy has been updated in line with recent government guidance. We would like to share the proposed changes to our curriculum and gather your feedback.

#### 2. Enquiring Minds (Mrs Green)

This term, we have been trialling a new curriculum approach designed to deepen children's learning, curiosity and engagement across the curriculum. Come along to find out more about our plans for September.

#### 3. Arbor Parent App and Communication System (Sofia)

From September, we will be moving to Arbor as our main communication platform. This Trust-wide change will replace our current text messaging service and ParentPay system. We will explain what this means for our families and how to get started.

#### 4. Developing Our Outdoor Learning Environment (Mrs Quiney)

We are launching our ambitious 3-5 year outdoor development plan to enhance our school grounds and expand opportunities for outdoor learning and play. Come along to view our architect's plans and find out more about our vision for the future.

## 5. The Good Morning Club (Miss Hunter-Purvis)
